Main Tasks

- contribute to the FTA negotiations by providing sectoral information to the EU Commission and other relevant stakeholders;
- produce analysis on the sector's overall competitiveness and trade performance;
- contribute to studies and researches about market dynamics that impact the EU textile value chain;
- support the senior policy manager in key legislative dossiers, such as (but not limited to): the revision of Regulation 1007/2011, the revision of the Union's Customs Code, the GSP reform;
- support the senior policy manager in operations (organisation, management and followup of internal and external meetings);
- support the organisation of events online and in person.

As a successful candidate, you should be able to think and work creatively, be reliable in planning and implementing your tasks, be able to listen, while not being afraid to ask for help.
